The project consisted of the redevelopment of the once glorious grounds at the Lourdes Stadium, which had fallen into decay, into a topclass international standard athletics facility.

Works undertaken within the renovated new stadium include a new 8-lane IAAF athletics track with 7.5m lighting columns and an arena for field games, as well as new club rooms to include changing rooms, and carparking facilities including 31 car spaces, two bus stands, eight bicycle stands and four disabled spaces.

The dedicated athletics facilities included an IAAF Standard 400m track with 8 oval and 8 straight lanes, as well as facilities for long and triple jump, high jump, pole vault and landing area, javelin throw and shot put.







## Post Contract

Post completion the stadium was independently tested and awarded an IAAF CLASS 1 Athletics Facility Certificate to enable it to hold international competitions. As part of this the track surface was also tested in situ and proven to conform to the specifications in the IAAF Track Facilities Testing Protocols. The lighting was also tested as part of this process. The building which houses the clubrooms and changing rooms was passed by the local authority building control and suitable certificates and approvals obtained.
